



A Memorandum of Understanding  
Between  
Fontys International Campus Venlo



and

Srinakharinwirot University

Both institutions agree to establish ties of friendship and cooperation for the purposes of promoting mutual understanding and possible exchange of faculty and students.

Fontys International Campus Venlo consists of two Fontys schools: Fontys International Business School and Fontys School of Logistics and Engineering, hereinafter referred to as FIBS represented by Thomas Merz, Managing Director, and as SWU represented by Associate Prit Supasetsiri, Acting Vice President for International Relations and Public mutually agree to promote exchange activities and international understanding.

#### OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this agreement shall include but are not be limited to the following:

1. The development of collaborative research projects involving our respective faculties.
2. The organization of joint academic and/or scientific activities, such as courses or lectures.
3. The exchange of research and teaching personnel.
4. The exchange of students, undergraduate.
5. The exchange of academic publications and other materials of common interest.

#### Administration and Implementation

1. This MoU will be in effect for a period of five (5) years at which time it shall be reviewed for possible extension.
2. Both institutions will designate an institutional coordinator to facilitate the development and conduction of the various activities.
3. The coordinators will be responsible for the direction and supervision of all activities of the joint programs under this agreement, subject to the rules and regulations pertaining to each institution.
4. The coordinator for Srinakharinwirot University, Ms. Sopin Chantakloi, Acting Director, International Relations Division, [ird@g.swu.ac.th](mailto:ird@g.swu.ac.th), 662-260-3637, and for Fontys International Campus Venlo, Linda Huskes, Head of International Office, [l.huskes@fontys.nl](mailto:l.huskes@fontys.nl), +31 885077454.
5. No financial obligations are assumed under this agreement. Funding for any specific program or activity shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to initiation of same.

6. The selection of students, faculty, and staff members participating in any exchange programs or projects will occur through a mutually agreed upon process between the two institutions.
7. Supplemental agreements will address such issues as: specific duties and responsibilities, schedules, budgets, evaluations, and any other items necessary to efficiently accomplish the activity.
8. The parties agree that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, or creed be excluded from participation under the terms of this Agreement.

#### Approval of the Memorandum of Understanding

This agreement will become effective upon being signed by the Presidents of both institutions. This agreement may be terminated by either party provided the terminating party gives written notice at least six (6) months prior to termination. The terms of this Agreement may be changed or modified only by written amendment signed by authorized agents of the parties hereto.
