



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) between THE HONGKONG POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY and SRINAKHARINWIROT UNIVERSITY

Department of Rehabilitation Sciences, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, Hong Kong and Faculty of Health Science, Srinakharinwirot University, Bangkok, Thailand are interested in bringing a more global dimension to their curricula and research particularly in the field of Physical Therapy.

The MOU, therefore, is made as a gesture of goodwill between the two institutes and mutual benefit through the cooperative effort in the following areas:

- 1. Exchange of students
- 2. Exchange of faculty members
- 3. Exchange of academic materials and other course information
- 4. Joint research activities and publications
- 5. Participation in seminars/ workshops and academic meetings
- 6. Participation in special short-term academic and cultural programs

This MOU shall be valid for **five years** from the date of signing. Revision or renewal of this cooperative link is subject to mutual consent of both parties.

It is expected that this MOU will lead to other more specific collaborative MOUs between the two institutions. Details of the implementation of any particular activities resulting from this MOU shall be negotiated between the two universities as such specific cases arise.

Either party may terminate the MOU by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the party initiating the notice. Such notification must be received by the other party at least six months prior to the effective date of termination.

This MOU serves as the intention of both parties to work together to promote academic and educational linkage. It does not have any legal binding effect on the part of the universities involved.
