

## Bilateral Agreement between University of Graz and Srinakharinwirot University



This bilateral agreement provides for cooperation between University of Graz (UG) and Srinakharinwirot University (SWU) in order to establish a partnership between these universities. The object of this cooperation is to promote joint research and cooperation in teaching in the fields of relevant environmental issues.

- 1 The agreement is based on the principle of reciprocity.
- In order to effectively cooperate in the field of joint environmental research and teaching in the fields of relevant environmental issues, the above mentioned institutions will develop various activities and programs and take measures in the following areas:
  - Exchange of researchers and students
  - b. Exchange of information on education and training, research and other related fields of activities
  - c. Participation of researchers and students in symposia, conferences, and other activities held by the two universities
  - d. Cooperation in the fields of relevant issues, such as sustainability studies, environmental sciences, tourism and the English language
- The details of each activity developed under this agreement (projects, duration, conditions, financing, distribution of tasks, conditions for admission ...) will be specified and agreed upon in writing before the respective activities take place. The details of recurring forms of cooperation will be specified in annexes to this Agreement.
- Annexes may be introduced into the present Bilateral Agreement upon acceptance by both parties.
- This agreement is valid for the duration of **five** (5) years starting on **1 July 2013**. This agreement will be reviewed by both parties every two years, with an option to suspend the agreement by either party.
