



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN IOWA
AND
SRINAKHARINWIROT UNIVERSITY**

In order to foster academic and research cooperation between The University of Northern Iowa and Srinakharinwirot University, the two institutions have reached the following understanding for a strategic partnership based upon principles of mutual equality and reciprocity of benefits:

1. The institutions will make suitable arrangements for the exchange of visiting scholars, faculty, staff, and post-doctoral fellows.
2. The institutions will seek opportunities to cooperate in a variety of academic/research areas.
3. The institutions will exchange scholarly information including research papers, indices to theses, books and magazines on relevant subjects where possible and appropriate.
4. The institutions will extend invitations for attending scholarly and technical meetings and assist in making arrangements for attending national and international conferences.
5. Arrangements concerning specific details of financial support will be made by individual written agreement applicable to each particular situation.
6. The names, crests and logos of the institutions are the intellectual property of those institutions, and may not be used without the express written permission of the institution that owns a particular name, crest or logo.
7. The Memorandum of Understanding will be in effect from the date of the last signature for a period of five years; it may be modified by mutual written consent. It shall be reviewed and upon mutual agreement may be extended for an additional three years. The Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated with at least six months written notice.
